Summary

EMPORIA4KT will improve transnational cooperation and synergies between triple helix players to foster innovation and competitiveness in the Atlantic Area's blue economy, by focusing on upgrading academia's skills for knowledge transfer and innovation.

The project will promote the design of market directed Research, Development & Innovation (RDI) projects, aiming to influence improvements in public policy through mapping RDI and knowledge transfer capacity, and supportive funding tools in the programme area.
